

BRING THE SONS OF JUBAL & JUBALHEIRS TO YOUR CHURCH

1. Who can host a concert?

The Sons of Jubal and Jubalheirs will come to any Baptist church so long as they have access to some facility adequate for hosting a concert (some churches have opted to have concerts in civic centers and other community facilities if their church isn't large enough).

2. Does someone on the staff have to be in the Jubals in order to host a concert?

No, many of our concerts are in churches where we do not have active members serving in the host church.

3. What is expected of the church?

The Sons of Jubal and Jubalheirs are mission organizations. As a result, we do request a love offering that goes to support these mission projects that are primarily related to Georgia Baptist mission causes. We also request a meal prior to the concert (we supplement the cost of the meal.). We also request that the church be active in promoting the concert to bring not only church members but also those without Christ.

4. Is there a waiting list for securing a concert?

Yes, it could take a year or more before securing a concert with either group. It is best to send the request as soon as possible. The officers of both groups review the requests and make recommendations for each concert season. We do our best to make sure we are in every region of the state each concert season.
